Work Achieved for 2019-2020

- Consolidation and streamlining of all financial matters has been achieved. A
 healthy corpus has been created and it will provide a sustainable inflow for
 all the work we are aiming to achieve.
- The alumni at present supports the education of 3 girls at the Aasara Trust.
 The One for One initiative spearheaded by Shruti Lakhanpal Tandon has been an inspiration for us and as a committee we are committed to achieving our target.
- The One for One is now supporting the education of 52 young street children at Aasara in Dehra Dun.
- The We Care initiative has been a source of support to our teachers who had left school many years ago. At present we provide a monthly income to 5 of our teachers. Any requirement for Medical help has also been provided by us.
- A Scholarship has been set up in School for the Class 4 staff. The Alumni will provide for the education of a girl child of one of the members of the staff. This scholarship will be at the school the child is presently studying in, the aim is to provide support to the Didi / Berahji / Maliji family by taking on the education and mentoring one of their daughters. The aim is to increase this to 5 girls in a few years. For this year we are committing to the education of one child till graduation. Opportunities for college scholarship for the future are also being looked in to.
- In this year we have also undertaken the responsibility of helping one of our young alumni, in continuing with her college education. Due to unfortunate circumstances in her family this brilliant young girl would have been deprived

- of a well-deserved education. The alumni have undertaken the responsibility of helping her by providing the funds for her three years in Delhi University.
- On the 14th of December 2018 we held the AGM as well as Tadpole Night, it was a lot of fun and the girls in Delhi and Mumbai had coordinated the event on the same evening. There was an excellent turnout at both venues.
- The Investiture Ceremony was held on the 1st of February this year and the Alumni welcomed the batch of 2019 into their fold.
